Student Conduct Guidelines for Summer School Program

Discipline problems will not be tolerated. Some serious disciplinary infractions include, but are not limited to, possession or use of alcohol or illegal drugs; possession of weapons; and fighting with or threatening other students. These infractions will lead to a dismissal from school and a forfeiture of all fees.

Failure to follow school policies will lead to infractions being documented in writing. Students who are given a written disciplinary infraction will be spoken to by one of the administrators and warned of future consequences. The administrators will also contact the student's parents or guardian. Two written infractions can lead to a one-day suspension (which will also count as an absence from school) and a failing grade on any work done in school that day. Behavior that merits a second suspension will lead to the student being expelled from school. Behaviors that lead to disciplinary problems include:

- All handbook rules apply

Other General Policies:

- No one is allowed away from the designated area during any break without administrative permission.
- If a student is not picked up within 30 minutes after class ends, parents will be charged \$5.00 per 15-minutes that the child is still on campus. Student will not be allowed to return to class until fee has been paid.
- No one may leave school early without permission.
- Non-students are not allowed on campus except for the dropping off or picking up of students. This includes the lunch break time from 10:30-11:00. During lunch or any break time, students should remain in the designated area. No meal deliveries accepted.
- Students may not use cell phones or electronic devices on the school grounds during the school day.
- If a student is absent, a parent or guardian must call the school at 340-6727, ext. 215 by 8:00 a.m.
- Attendance is crucial. **If a student misses more than three days, the school reserves the right to dismiss the student and to deny credit for the course.**
- If a student is tardy to class twice, the administration will consider this an absence from class. A student will be marked tardy if he/she is more than 10 minutes late.
- Extracurricular school activities held during the summer such as band, cheering, pep squad, and dance team camps are activities for which the student may be away from school. However, participation in such activities must be reported at the beginning of summer school and arrangements must be made with the school. If a student takes time away from school for one of these activities, he/she is responsible for any adverse effects on grades.

Dress Policy

- All students must wear their school uniform properly.
- Students must wear the official uniform shoe. No other shoes will be allowed.

Drop off/ Pick up Policy

- Students are to be dropped off at the main entrance of the school using the Westbank Expressway entrance at 1000 Salesian Lane. no earlier than 7:15 a.m.
- Students must be picked up by 11:00 if attending a morning session or by 2:30 if attending an afternoon session.
- Students remaining on campus after the appropriate times will be charged \$5.00 for each additional 15-minutes. Payment must be made prior to student returning to school the next day.
