**Fee Waivers** - Fee waivers are available to junior and senior students who participate in the Federal free and reduced lunch program. You must fill out the application at <a href="https://www.schoolcafe.org">www.schoolcafe.org</a> to determine your eligibility. Receiving free lunch at school this year does not automatically qualify you for the fee waiver. A total of 4 fee waivers may be used by a single student over his high school career, beginning in the junior year.

## **Registration Tips**

- The most important thing to remember when registering at **myact.org** is to meet the deadline. Late charges apply. The current cost of the test is \$60.00.
- Students are recommended to begin testing by the beginning of the junior year. A student may test as often as they wish and is never penalized for a lower score, meaning your highest score is always recognized.
- Be sure to include the **TOPS 4 digit code of 1595** on your registration. This assures that your score will be sent directly to the student financial aid office. *VERY IMPORTANT if you wish to secure TOPS*.
- Athletes who anticipate playing collegiate sports are encouraged to list the NCAA athletic association on your registration as well. That code is 9999.
- When registering, students may select up to 4 colleges or institutions to receive a score copy. You may select more, however fees will apply.
- Students are encouraged to rotate your college choices around so that your score may be sent to multiple schools.
- Archbishop Shaw is a National testing center for all tests this academic year, except for the July test. You
  may select to test at Shaw, test center code 206320, or any school you desire.

- Students are responsible for bringing in a PRINTED admission ticket, proper identification, a sharpened pencil and an ACT approved calculator. At the present time, face masks are required.
